It all began in 2010 when ArtsNaples sponsored the appearance of the Odessa Philharmonic Orchestra from Ukraine. Since then, ArtsNaples has reached out to an audience of over thirty thousand with its first three festivals and continues to expand with year-round events. ArtsNaples not only has deep roots in the community, but also throughout the world through its partnerships with Opera Naples, the von Liebig Art Center, Collier County Public Libraries, Artis-Naples, the Sugden Community Theatre, Naples Botanical Garden, Collier County Schools, FGCU, the Curtis Institute, the Carnegie Academy, the Golisano Children's Museum, Naples International Film Festival, Classic Chamber Concerts, the Collier County Museums and many others. ArtsNaples is proud to enhance and expand the local, regional and international reputation of Naples, Florida, as a special destination for the cultural arts.
